










TLP Coordinator Survey



1. LMC's Academic Senate believes that there is enough work connected to the Teaching and Learning Program Coordinator (TLP) position to justify a 100% load. They have recommended, by a vote of 9-2 (with 2 abstentions), that this job should be filled by a new tenure track faculty position through Box 2A, rather than through release time. Other LMC faculty members believe that the job is better filled through release time. Other options include creating a new classified hire to work with professors on SLOs, or creating a new managerial position whose job would be to oversee faculty on SLOs. What do you believe would be the best fit for a Teaching and Learning Program Coordinator?


