











**1. Should the UF agree to add two teaching days (one Thursday each semester) to the 2014-2015 academic calendar and reduce full-time faculty's FLEX obligation by 2 days for the year. This would be a one-year agreement only in order to give students and faculty with Thursday classes more time to prepare for final exams.**

**2. Because the semester ends on a Wednesday this year, graduation ceremonies have also been scheduled on Wednesday (to avoid holding a Friday graduation on a day that is not a "service day" for faculty). This has created a conflict for some students and faculty who have Wednesday-night final exams at the same time as graduation. Should the UF agree for one year only to move graduation ceremonies to Friday at the end of the 2014/2015 academic year, even though the semester will end on a Wednesday or Thursday (depending on whether we change the calendar as described above)? Full-time faculty who would normally be required to attend graduation would still be required to attend and would not receive any additional compensation. Attending graduation would count as a FLEX activity.**
