LMC Biology Department Co-Chairs, Durwynne Hseih and Briana McCarthy requested a contract variance to allow Briana McCarthy who is a 4^{th} year tenure-track professor in the department to evaluate two new Biology adjunct instructors for the fall 2017 semester. Joe Zermeno and Larissa Wiggins. Briana , Joe and Larissa all mutually agree to this arrangement.

Following a motion by Keating, seconded by Michels, MSU, to approve the variance to allow Briana McCarthy who is a 4th year tenure-track professor in the department to evaluate two new Biology adjunct instructors for the fall 2017 semester.

4. LEADERSHIP REPORTS –

CCC's VP, Michels reported Ken Sherwood is the new College Vice President and Tish Young is the new Senior Dean of Instruction. CCC hired Kathleen Hargan as coordinator for the equity hour program. Michels will hold a MAaM equity hour program training workshop and a faculty evaluation training workshop in early September.

DVC's VP, Mayfield reported the DVC scheduling committee has not had their meeting this semester. The Faculty development committee meets on Monday August 28, 2017. Mayfield went on to say he held 2 faculty evaluation training workshops during flex week and he will schedule an evaluation workshop at the San Ramon campus within the next few weeks. Mayfield stated he is working on a recruitment of new UF Executive Board members.

LMC's VP, Clarke, discussed the Guided Pathways program, and the two new CTE Leads. Clarke went on to say that he addressed the Nexus Group and plans on holding faculty evaluation trainings mid-September.

Part-time Faculty Advocate, Dildine, stated the Equity Hour Orientation for new adjunct faculty was a success and that they had a large turnout.
